Applicants must have successfully completed a 5-year General Surgery Residency accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) and be eligible for board certification from the ABS by start of the fellowship August 1 – respectively.

The academic year begins August 1st with orientation beginning the last week of July.

How to Apply:

Step 1

- Current Curriculum Vitae
- Official test transcripts for all applicable examinations (USMLE Step 1, 2, 3 or COMLEX scores)
- ECFMG certificate (if you graduated from medical school outside the USA)
- ABSITE scores (from the American Board of Surgery)
- Personal statement
- Photograph
- Medical school transcript

Step 2

All candidates must register for the: National Resident Matching Program's (NRMP) https://www.nrmp.org/

Deadline to apply is January 31st.

Interviews are conducted virtually during February and March each year.

Applicants scheduled for an interview will be invited to a virtual program presentation by our program director, Mark A. Mattos, MD.
